Earning Privileges, Building Character

At Breakthrough Academy, we believe that privileges grow from accountability, responsibility, and effort. These privileges may include leadership roles, expanded project choices, hands-on agricultural experiences, off-campus learning, or greater independence in their daily work. This approach helps students understand that their actions and effort directly influence the opportunities available to them.

By connecting responsibility to opportunity, students begin to develop essential life skills. They learn to take ownership of their
